Dear EBES Members,

We have successfully organized *our 37th EBES Conference* on October 6-8, 2021. The conference was jointly organized with the *GLO* (*Global Labor Organization*) with the support of the *Istanbul Economic Research Association* and in collaboration with the *FOM University of Applied Sciences*. Due to the COVID-19, the conference presentation mode was switched to "online/virtual presentation only".

We are honored to have received top-tier papers from distinguished scholars from all over the world. In the conference, 177 papers by 379 colleagues from 54 countries were presented.

The conference days kicked off with the delivery of the opening speech by Mehmet Huseyin Bilgin, *Vice President of EBES*; Manuela Zipperling, *Head of FOM University of Applied Sciences in Berlin*; and Azita Berar Awad, *Chairperson of the United Nations Research Institute for Social Development (UNRISD)* & *Policy Director of the GLO* & *Graduate Institute of International and Development Studies, Geneva*. Klaus F. Zimmermann, *EBES and GLO President*, talked on the "Future of Global Mobility" on the same day, whereas David G. Blanchflower, *Dartmouth College* & *GLO*, provided the keynote speech on his paper entitled "The Economics of Walking About and Predicting Unemployment". Furthermore, Dorothea Schäfer and Marco Vivarelli, *editors-in-chief for Eurasian Economic Review* and *Eurasian Business Review*, respectively, shared their experience on how to publish in WoS journals.





On the second day, the plenary speech was given by Sriya Iyer, *University of Cambridge* & *GLO*, on "Religion and Mental Health". The conference continued with the joint *GLO-FOM* session and special *GLO* sessions on "Migration" and "Family & Household Economics" in addition to the other top-tier sessions.

Last but not least, the best paper award was given to "Manager Gender, Entrepreneurial Orientation and SMEs Export and Import Propensities: Evidence from Spanish Business" by Alfonso Expósito García from *University of Malaga*, Spain; Amparo Sanchis-Llopis from *University of Valencia* and *ERICES*, Spain; and Juan A. Sanchis Llopis from *University of Valencia* and *ERICES*, Spain.
